

# A KUNLUN NEI GUNG teacher is coming to the Seattle area to give a class!

He is also a Reiki Master, studied Hawaiian Huna Healing for 12 years with Kahuna Nahi Ena Ena, studied ancient Huna healing with the Maoris in New Zealand, studied Chi Gong with Grand Master Chin Yin, and most important, studied Kunlun with Sifu /Ching Fung Dao Shr / Lama Ngakpa Dorje / Max Christensen.

Rich has been teaching Kunlun in Hawaii and doing seminars around the country for the last three years. Currently, he is living at the James Gilliland ECETI Ranch in Trout Lake, Washington, where he is teaching classes and traveling to give seminars around the globe. There will be two different events during Rich’s stay in the Seattle area:

- (1) On Friday June 5, there will be a free lecture (6:30 – 8:00 p.m.) where people are invited to come and learn about Kunlun Nei Gung, ask questions, and find out if this appeals to them. There is no charge for this introductory lecture.
- (2) On June 6 – 7, there will be an intensive, experiential two-day class. The times are 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. on Saturday and 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. on Sunday. If you sign up, you are expected to attend both sessions, for a full 8-hour intensive. It is also a good idea to sign up for the intro lecture. The cost of the two-day intensive is \$200. Please bring cash or a check.

Both events will be at the home of Carol and Vyto Babrauskas. We are located in Issaquah (Preston village), about 30 minutes due east of Seattle, directly on I-90. Purified drinking water will be available, but we will not serve food. While we can accommodate 40+ people for classes, we cannot accommodate 40 cars coming to park. So, those of you who can, it will be good if you can share rides.
